Re: **LLW Forum Publications on the World Wide Web**

In April 1994, in an effort to increase distribution of LLW Forum materials, the organization agreed to cooperate with the U.S. Department of Energy's National Low-Level Waste Management Program at the Idaho National Engineering and Environmental Laboratory to print and distribute copies of those materials on request to members of the public. While this project has successfully met its initial outreach goals, technology now offers an opportunity to distribute our materials more broadly.

Therefore, the LLW Forum has decided to add issues of *LLW Notes* and Meeting Reports to the LLW Forum World Wide Web page. The first newly posted publication, the LLW Forum Meeting Report, February 10-13, 1998, will appear in March. Copies of the LLW Forum's *Summary Report: Low-Level Radioactive Waste Management Activities in the States and Compacts* will continue to appear on the LLW Forum web page.

Over the years, many *LLW Notes* recipients have expressed a desire to receive the newsletter sooner after publication. Posting the *LLW Notes* on the Internet will allow readers to access the document as soon as it is published. It will also allow us to conserve natural resources by reducing the number of paper copies sent to INEEL.

The LLW Forum will continue to provide single copies of written materials in camera-ready format to all Forum Participants as well as to many other state, compact and federal officials -- including the DOE program at INEEL -- to reproduce and distribute as they deem fit. The staff of the LLW Forum will also refer any person requesting printed copies of the referenced or any other LLW Forum materials to the appropriate Forum Participant or federal agency official.
